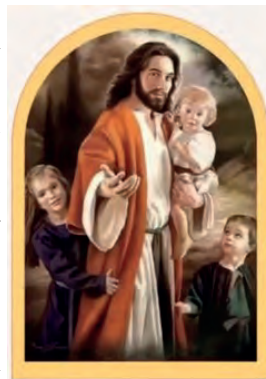
We are preparing to begin 2023-2024 Religious Education. Enrollment is now open on the parish website at www.sfxhyannis.org.
