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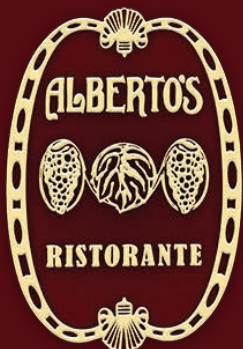

Through your deeply appreciated financial commitment in the form of your weekly tithing to our Lord, our parish family ministry is strong and growing in service to our Lord.

During this past fiscal year, we have implemented systems and processes to improve our efficiency and through your ongoing weekly generosity continued to meet our annual operations expenses. As an example of the value of your offerings, we will not charge registration or book fees for our Religious Education Program which now approaches 300 children enrolled during the next fiscal year.

We have also completed the second of three phases of our plan to progressively address our major building and grounds infrastructure issues. During fiscal year 2025, we replaced the failing fence at St Patrick's Cemetery, installed new rug at St Francis Xavier Church and restored the exterior of Sacred Heart Chapel along with several other safety and exterior lighting improvements across the campus.

We thank for your prayers, support, commitment and, in advance, for your ongoing consideration.
