As you may have noticed we have six new swings on our playground. I am very grateful to PTG for covering the cost of those swings and to Mr. Opresko who installed them. Our students, no matter what their age, really enjoy them.

This is a friendly reminder that no car can be parked in the school zone at any time during arrival and dismissal. Our car riders are dismissed on Willard. Please do not pick up your child on Edgerton. This is reserved for buses ONLY.

This year we have many more “walkers” than in previous years. We do have a crossing guard every morning and afternoon on S.Dallas and Edgerton. For the safety of our children please make sure they are crossing this busy road with the crossing guard. Edgerton has also become very busy. I try to be there to help our students cross, however due to meetings I am not always there. Please stay within the speed limits, and be careful dropping off your children. We know there are issues with cars not following speed limits. Please feel free to contact local authorities for some kind of solution. Our request for speed bumps or lights on S.Dallas were denied last year.

Please see the attached message from one of our parents that is asking all of us to take action regarding the traffic issues:

As you know the traffic situation in Point Breeze has only gotten worse with the bridge collapse. I have tried to take action to get changes made--stop signs put back in place at the S. Murtland/Reynolds and S. Lang/Reynolds intersections as well as speed humps on S. Murtland and Reynolds--to hopefully help restore traffic safety and order to our Point Breeze neighborhood.

As a parent I am worried about my kids, and the kids in the neighborhood, walking to school, riding their bikes, etc. on the streets.
