FIRST SUNDAY AFTER EASTER - LOW SUNDAY DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY Sunday, April 16, 2023

Today, following the 11:15AM Mass, Coffee and Donuts will be available before the Divine Mercy Service begins at 1PM. Exposition to begin the DM service and Benediction to close at 2PM. Confessions will be available after Mass from 1PM-3PM. Today, a plenary indulgence is granted to those who, under the usual conditions, take part in the public devotion to His <u>Divine Mercy</u> or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (in the tabernacle or exposed), recite the Our Father, the Creed, and a prayer to Jesus appealing to His mercy. <u>Jesus's words to St Faustina:</u> I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109). Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300).


