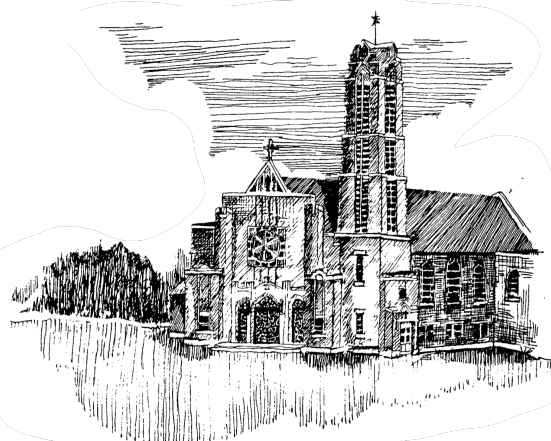

FLOCKNOTE

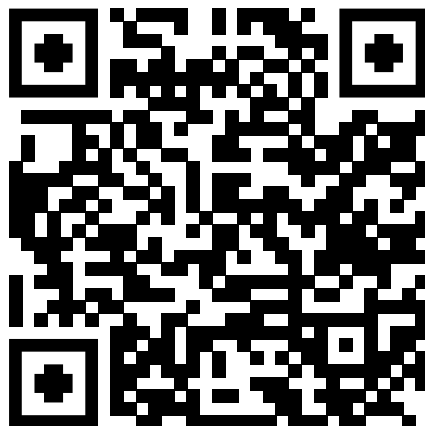
