2023 MISSION COOPERATIVE PLAN

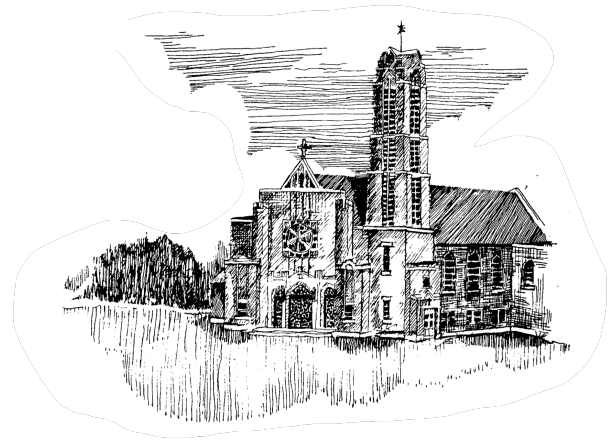
