

Once parishioners have had an opportunity to submit these 4 intentions and they are added to the Mass book, the Mass Schedule will be opened again for the first quarter (February to April) and you will have another opportunity to have additional Masses offered, depending on availability. Dates can be selected from the entire year. Additional mass requests from *February through end of April* may be submitted using Pew envelopes and enclosing a \$15 Mass stipend.
