We will now be purchasing a few concrete pavers for West door exits and have plans for watering in the spring to make sure that the new grass will "take". Thanks so much!

**St. Augustine Dual-Fuel:** We have now received two different proposals (propane or electric brick-heat-storage units) to help our Church qualify for the Dual-Fuel electric rates. The Council will review the proposals soon and come to a decision. If we are able to work this out, it will mean our heating costs will drop from one half to one third of what we presently pay. More details to come – we hope to accomplish this yet in the 2021-2022 heating season.

<u>Mass Times Survey:</u> There has been some discussion about possibly doing a survey on our present rotation of Mass Times. Given that Fr. Bachmeier may be moved next summer and that a new priest might change the Mass times again, it was felt that it is best to wait until 2023 before any change in Mass-times is considered.

<u>October Mass Counts:</u> During the month of October, every parish in the world takes a census of Mass attendance. Fr. Bachmeier will plan on doing the counts from the Presider's chair at each parish unless some generous volunteer will be at all the Masses at their parish and wants to do the counting there?!?
