SOMETHING NEW IN CHRIST

Jesus knew that the scribes and Pharisees were trying to trap him. They put him in what seemed to be a no-win situation. Let the woman who was caught in adultery go, and he would have been accused of ignoring the law. Let her be stoned, and he would fail to show mercy toward her, contradicting his life's message. Jesus' response teaches three crucial lessons: none of us is free of sin; we are not the ultimate judges of others; Jesus is the mercy of God, in whom we can always trust. In Christ, God does something new. When we give our hearts to Christ, we have the hope of new life, a life in which mercy reigns.

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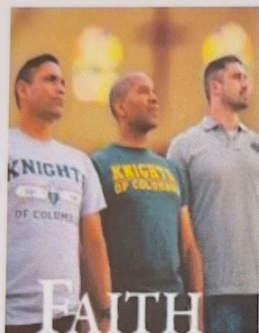

ALGO NUEVO EN CRISTO

Jesús sabía que los escribas y los fariseos estaban tratando de atraparlo. Ellos lo pusieron en lo que parecía ser un callejón sin salida. Si dejaba ir a la mujer sorprendida en adulterio, sería acusado de ignorar la ley. Si dejaba que la apedrearán, fallaría en mostrar misericordia hacia ella, contradiciendo el mensaje de su vida. La respuesta de Jesús enseña tres lecciones cruciales: ninguno de nosotros está libre de pecado; no somos los jueces supremos de los demás; Jesús es la misericordia de Dios, en quien siempre podemos confiar. En Cristo, Dios hace algo nuevo. Cuando damos nuestros corazones a Cristo, tenemos la esperanza de una nueva vida, una vida en la que la misericordia reina.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Esta semana recordamos a San Isidro (560-621) el Obispo de Sevilla que en el 2002 fue nombrado uno de los posibles santos patronos del Internet por el Consejo Pontificio de Comunicación Social. Este santo hispano nunca usó el ciberespacio, pero sí fue el primero en hacer lo que el Internet tiene de bueno, reunir información de todo tipo en un sólo lugar para poder ser consultado fácilmente (user friendly). Esta obra de San Isidro es de 20 libros y se llama *Etymologiae*, o “Origines”. Es la primera enciclopedia y trata de dar al lector una base de datos (database) de información sobre todo tipo de temas en forma de pequeños flashes.

La Iglesia desde siglos ha propuesto a los santos patronos para todo tipo de persona, de obra y de pasatiempos. Estos son modelos y protectores del uso correcto de nuestras habilidades humanas y para evitar abusos. Lamentablemente el Internet se usa para divulgar todo tipo de basura y calumnias. Sin embargo, hay que reconocer que esta herramienta puede ser un instrumento valioso para proclamar la palabra de Dios y el amor al prójimo.
