

#### **Baptism**

- 3rd Sunday monthly, after 10 a.m. Mass; please pre-register and submit sponsor certificates at least 1 week prior to the baptism
- Pre-Baptism class for first child <u>ONLY</u> as required by the Diocese; offered the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of January, April, July and October at 11:30 a.m. in Mary's Room. Registration is required.

## Anointing of the Sick Celebrated at Masses annually during October or at home at the request of the family.

- •In cases of emergency: at hospital or other medical facility when a priest is available.
- •In non-emergency cases: call the parish or a Catholic hospital chaplain nearest the location of person to be anointed.

#### Holy Communion for the Homebound

Call to arrange for Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Priest visits on First Friday. Please call if you are ill and confined to home.

#### **Hospital Calls**

Please notify the Parish Office when you or a member of your family is hospitalized. Be sure to let the hospital know that you are Catholic and if you would like the Catholic Chaplain to visit. If it is an emergency, be sure to call the priest on call. Most hospitals also have Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who bring Holy Communion to Catholic patients. Let your nurse know you are a Catholic and would like to receive Holy Communion.

#### **Sponsor Requirements**

Direct requests for sponsor certificates to a priest. Individuals must

- be registered and practicing members of the parish
- be at least 16 years of age
- and have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation
- if married, be in a marriage accepted by the Catholic Church.

### Opening of The Year of the Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

The Holy Father has announced that 2025 will be a Jubilee Year, something which happens every 25 years. The theme for Jubilee 2025 is "Pilgrims of Hope," and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the current climate crisis.

The Diocese of Cleveland will open the Jubilee Year 2025 with a sacred pilgrimage and Mass on Sunday, Dec. 29, the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. All are invited to gather at St. Peter Church (E 17th and Superior) at 4:30 pm. Liturgy will begin there with prayer, proclamation of a Gospel passage, and reading of some sections of the Bull of Indiction of the Jubilee Year. All gathered will join a solemn procession to the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist, led by the cross of Christ. Once at the Cathedral, Mass will continue (at 5:30 pm) as usual. Bishop Malesic has designated eleven Sacred Jubilee Sites, 8 parishes (one in each county of the Diocese of Cleveland) and three shrines.


