




### PRAYER FOR PROTECTION AGAINST STORMS AND HURRICANES




### THE BIBLE COLLECTION - PAUL THE APOSTLE

### A Stewardship Moment


Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Weekend of June 25/26, 2022

Today's Gospel reveals to us the beginning of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem. We will journey with Jesus for many Sundays to come, and along the way he will teach us about the demands of discipleship. His instructions may seem harsh and unreasonable to our ears. His response to legitimate requests to postpone the journey reminds us that there are always justifiable excuses to defer the journey or put off the responsibilities of discipleship. Other important matters compete for our attention. Some of us must make heart-wrenching choices, but there is urgency about Jesus' mission to bring forth God's kingdom. His demand is that we proclaim the Kingdom of God now. Is this our first priority, or do we have other priorities?

### COMPENDIUM-CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

### Q: Why did Christ institute an ecclesiastical hierarchy?

A: Christ instituted an ecclesiastical hierarchy with the mission of feeding the people of God in his name and for this purpose gave it authority. The hierarchy is formed of sacred ministers: bishops, priests, and deacons. Thanks to the sacrament of Orders, bishops and priests act in the exercise of their ministry in the name and person of Christ the Head. Deacons minister to the people of God in the diakonia (service) of word, liturgy, and charity. (CCC 874-877, 935)






