LITURGICAL REFLECTION

In today's first reading, the ancient Israelites are asked to rejoice in the Lord for his gift of abundant food, and to give a portion to those who had nothing. As Christian stewards, we are called to do the same. Our gifts are our food to share. In St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians, it states "If they were all one part, where would the body be? But as it is there are many parts, yet one Body." St. Paul teaches us as Christian stewards that we all have equal dignity and worth in God's sight and we should view each other in this same light. It teaches us to humbly recognize our own gifts as well as the giftedness of every member of our parish family. And, while God has designed us to ultimately depend on Him, it seems He has also designed us to need each other! The good news of the beauty and richness of a stewardship way of life is that God does not ask any one person to "do it all" in their family or parish. He simply asks us to share the gifts and talents we do have in the season of life we find ourselves in right now. It might feel uncomfortable to say "No" sometimes.
