"EPHAPHATHA", that is "be opened!"

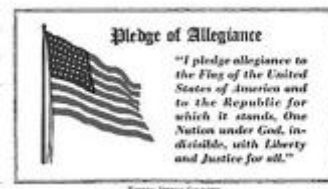
In the gospel of Mark, Jesus is moving around widely, he enters Tyre and Sidon, two pagan cities in today's Lebanon and then he crosses the region of Galilee, and proceeds again to non-Jewish territory to the east of the Sea of Galilee. Along the way, "*people brought him a deaf man who had a speech impediment.*" Jesus led the poor man away from the crowd and with some symbolic gestures and even groaning up to Heaven, he opens the man's ear with the word "*Ephaphatha*", that is "*be opened!*"

This same word "*Ephaphatha*" is also part of the Rite of Baptism: before Covid, the minister would pronounce it loud and clear touch-ing the baby's mouth and ears. "*May your ears and your mouth be opened to hear the Word of God and to proclaim it.*" Satan wants us "*earth-bound*", deaf to God's Word and unable to witness it. "*Lord, open my lips; and my mouth will proclaim your praise.*" (Psalm 51: 17)

ONE NATION, UNDER GOD, INDIVISIBLE, WITH LIBERTY AND JUSTICE FOR ALL

When a nation is united as one large family, with its citizens looking out for each other's well-being and dignity, tragedy and violence always hit hard and deeply lacerate the heart and the soul of caring men and women. It happened 20 years ago on September 11, 2001, here in Washington at the Pentagon, in New York City at the Twin Towers and in the open fields of Pennsylvania. It happened once again less than a week ago in Afghanistan, where 13 young men and women (and with them many others seeking freedom and dignity), were struck down and killed in cold blood by followers of the "Covenant of death."

As Christians, we are **EASTER PEOPLE**, and we know and believe that death does not have and will never have the last word.

The prophet Isaiah also denounced the "Covenant of death" (Isaiah 28: 15,18) and summoned his people to have faith in the Lord, as the only hope. Isaiah lived in very crucial times: the nation of Israel was about to be swallowed up by powerful alliances all around. Israel, a very small nation but in a strategic location, joined one of these alliances to survive. But Isaiah, one of the most powerful prophets of the Old Testament, smelled the trap and openly opposed his faith-less king and asked him to trust in God. The king didn't listen to Isaiah and he and his whole nation ended up in exile for over 75 years. *Those who put their hope in their weapons and in the logic and powers of earth are bound to perish, victims of their own foolishness. We live on the earth but are not of the earth.*
