We have two middle school students that will most likely go to Denmark next year.

I would like to split the students this way:

3K-Lori Wagner (9 total right now)

4K-Josette Smithson (8 total right now)

K- Mrs. Matyka (5-6 students)

5-7/8 Mrs. Mader (5 students)

Gr 1-4 -4 to 5 students (with a new teacher or the gr 1 could go with kindergarten)

It would not be good for the students to have one teacher for gr 1-7 (or 8). The elementary and intermediate numbers are difficult to group. With another teacher we can group students by grade and/or subject and two teachers could share the teaching of grades 1-7/8.

If we cannot hire a teacher, I would propose another teacher's aide who could assist Mrs. Mader and Mrs. Matyka with all the K-8 students.

School choice numbers are up, for 24-25 we currently have 10 students and I have one in the process of applying. A couple of new families have been given the information and I will continue to help them apply if they qualify. School Choice is only 4K-8 and new families. Currently this will bring in almost \$100,000 in choice dollars.

We are looking at working with Cherrydale for fundraising in the Fall and possibly Spring. I will need to coordinate with Jessica and our Home and School organization. This would be a product-based fundraiser (both food and seasonal items), with catalogs as well as online options for out-of-town family and friends.

Lunch program will most likely be dropped due to no delivery & service from Denmark. Students will have to bring cold lunch. We will be able to continue to provide milk through the district. Our only other option is to hire a person to shop and prepare the food here. This does not seem feasible currently.
