Paula Gauthier – Perpetual Care investment

Oct. 2 – Betty, Paula, Alex, and Father met and came up with a recommendation made for \$20,000 be invested 60% in stock, 40% in bonds. The other \$50,000 would remain on the CD. Come back in 6 months to compare amounts and decide on any changes. Paula wants input from the Finance Council as to what to do. Finance Council agreed to try this recommendation for 6 months.
