Grocery delivery apps are all the rage these days, and I can't deny the convenience of tapping your finger a few times and seeing your week's shopping dropped on the doorstep. But there is one aspect of this trend that seems to make a lot of shoppers nervous — fruits and vegetables.

A lot of us have strong opinions on our fresh produce and aren't ready to delegate this highly subjective selection process to a total stranger. My father was a produce manager and I remember as a child learning about the complexities of choosing correctly. Getting a bad bag of under ripe tomatoes after shopping on an app could easily sour one on the whole idea.

Forrest Gump said life is like a box of chocolates. I say, we're all like grab-bags of produce dumped on someone's doorstep — but if we're Christians who live our faith publicly, we're stamped with the name of God. If your thumb is green enough, you know that you can tell a lot about a gardener from the produce he grows. We who are planted in the house of the Lord — what do we reveal about our Gardener?

What do our actions show of His teachings? What do our words reflect of His voice? What does our strength reveal of the soil from which we sprang and the life-giving waters that nourished us?

When we open ourselves up to those we encounter, let's make a special effort to show the care we have had — lest our peers come away from the experience thinking God doesn't know how to garden, when in reality, it's us who don't always know how to grow. — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS ©LPi

ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MAS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

8º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Siempre que vamos al súper, llegamos con el buen deseo de escoger lo mejor. Especialmente la fruta, la queremos fresca, jugosa y dulce. Has pensado en los árboles de donde proviene la fruta. ¿Serán buenos, estarán bien regados y vitaminados? Porque depende del árbol cómo es que será su fruto, bueno o malo. Hoy, es día de examen, para saber cómo andamos de frutos. Mucho depende de lo que llevamos dentro del corazón y Jesús, sin rodeos, lanza la siguiente pregunta: *“¿Puede un ciego guiar a otro ciego? Ciertamente caerán ambos en algún hoyo”* (Lucas 6:39). Desde luego que no, alguno de los dos debe tener visión clara y saber hacia dónde se dirige. Observemos bien qué tipo de fruto esta dando nuestra vida y eso se mide en el refrán que dice: Obras son amores, y no buenas razones.

El Papa Francisco, también lo explica de la siguiente manera: *“Los niños y los jóvenes son los frutos de los árboles. Y cuando un árbol tiene buenas raíces y un buen tronco (abuelos y padres) da buenos frutos. Debemos ser un bosque lleno de buenos frutos; las familias numerosas son una gran esperanza de la sociedad”*. Todos por lo general tendemos a cuidar las apariencias, por lo tanto, descuidamos lo más importante, el interior del corazón, que es de donde sale lo bueno: *“La boca habla de lo que está lleno el corazón”* (Lucas 6:45). Meet Blessed Fray Elias del Socorro Nieves, OSA

- ⇒ Nació en Yuriria, Guanajuato en 1882
- ⇒ A los 21 años ingreso al seminario Agustiniiano.
- ⇒ Se ordenó sacerdote en 1916.
- ⇒ Vivió en el tiempo de la persecución religiosa en México.
- ⇒ En 1926 se estableció en la cueva de un cerro, en la celebraba Misa.
- ⇒ Atendió clandestinamente a sus feligreses durante 14 meses.
- ⇒ En 1928 fue descubierto y asesinado.
- ⇒ Antes de morir el P. Nieves dio la bendición a los soldados y comenzó a recitar el Credo.
- ⇒ Sus ultimas palabras fueron ¡Viva Cristo Rey!
- ⇒ Fue beatificado por San Juan Pablo II, en 1997.



- ⇒ He was born in Yuriria, Guanajuato in 1882.
- ⇒ At age 21 he entered the Augustinian seminary.
- ⇒ He was ordained a priest in 1916.
- ⇒ He lived at the time of religious persecution in Mexico.
- ⇒ In 1926 he settled in a cave on a hill, where he celebrated Mass.
- ⇒ He clandestinely served his parishioners for 14 months.
- ⇒ In 1928 he was discovered and murdered.
- ⇒ Before dying, Father Nieves gave his blessing to the soldiers and began to recite the Creed.
- ⇒ His last words were “Long live Christ the King!”
- ⇒ He was beatified by St. John Paul II in 1997.
