The Church’s definition of fasting is only eating one meal in the day, with two smaller meals not equaling one meal if needed, and no snacking in between. On a fast day, liquids can be consumed at any time (with the exception of liquids that can be considered a meal). Abstinence means not eating the flesh of warm-blooded animals.

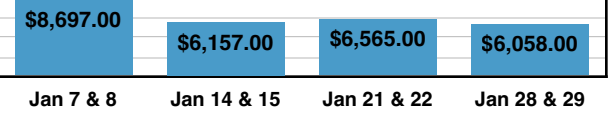
