



ASH WEDNESDAY IS A DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE from eating meat. The Church's definition of fasting is only eating one meal in the day, with two smaller meals not equaling one meal if needed, and no snacking in between. On a fast day, liquids can be consumed at any time (with the exception of liquids that can be considered a meal). Abstinence means not eating the flesh of warm-blooded animals.
