Moved by so much suffering Christ not only allows himself to be touched by the sick, but he makes their miseries his own: “He took our infirmities and bore our diseases.” But he did not heal all the sick. His healings were signs of the coming of the Kingdom of God. They announced a more radical healing: the victory over sin and death through his

Passover. On the cross Christ took upon himself the whole weight of evil and took away the “sin of the world,” of which illness is only a consequence. By his passion and death on the cross Christ has given a new meaning to suffering: it can henceforth configure us to him and unite us with his redemptive Passion.

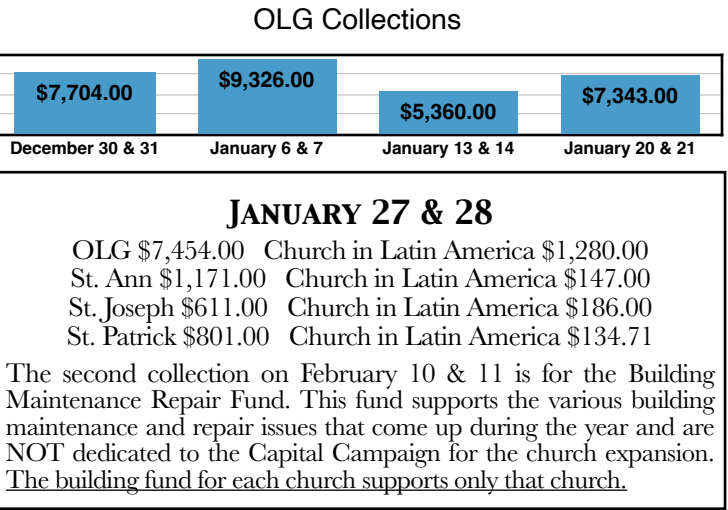

ASH WEDNESDAY IS A DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE from eating meat. The Church’s definition of  
fasting is only eating one meal in the day, with two smaller meals not equaling one meal if needed, and no  
snacking in between. On a fast day, liquids can be consumed at any time (with the exception of liquids that can  
be considered a meal). Abstinence means not eating the flesh of warm-blooded animals.
