BARC Remodel Phase 2

December 2018

OVERVIEW

Install a new top layer of Skatelite on all the ramps/structures at the BARC. Raise enough money to build a 3' micro ramp on the backside of the new 6' mini ramp.

PLAN SPECIFICS

Two years ago, following a successful fundraising campaign, coordinated with BARC stewards Mark Brown and Dave Wilke, we raised enough money to purchase the materials to build a 6'x20' mini ramp. The second phase of this remodel was planned as a re-layer the mini ramp and as much of park as possible, based on the amount of material we could afford. Through networking and coordinating with Ryan Spence of Skatelite, we have procured a donation from Skatelite, which is based in Tacoma, of a much needed entire re-layer of all ramps in the park (approx. 75 sheets worth over \$16k). Using donated labor by my group of friends (see attached resume) that have been building local skateparks for 25+ years, we will get this final phase of the indoor park remodel done over the course of 5 days (Wednesday – Sunday, schedule TBD). Skatelite has agreed to hold the sheets for us to allow time for Parks Department to review our proposal and to approve an acceptable schedule for the remodel.

TIMELINE

Prep/De-layer - Wednesday PM to Friday PM

Park shut down Wednesday afternoon to begin removing top layer from all ramps/features.

Re-layer/Micro Ramp Build - Friday PM to Sunday PM

Build micro ramp behind 6' mini ramp. Re-layer all features of the park. Repair any damages to underlayment or structures (minimal if at all).
