To the members of the Vashon Island Park District Board:

My interest in serving on the board of the Vashon Park District stems from my lifelong affiliation with Vashon, my active participation in the equestrian community here, and a desire to maintain, protect, and improve the opportunities that the Park District offers Vashon residents and visitors. Given the recent changes to the Park District's funding I have become increasingly aware of the complexities and challenges facing our parks and the importance of becoming active in the issues we are now facing as a community.

I remember Vashon before the park district: I had outdoor recess during rainy afternoons where the BARC skate park now resides, I scuffed the dirt under the swings just beyond the Old Gym where the impressive sport fields now have lights, watering, and state of the art footing, and I rode through the State Lands to traverse Vashon upwards of two hours to get to the Horse Park - The Horse Park which is one of the best examples of democratizing equestrianism anywhere in King County, and perhaps in the state. Since my youth I have seen the parks develop and improve— and those changes have been positive for the community.

Having also lived in Seattle and other cities (including 3 months in Shanghai) one of the greatest legacies all these places have are their parks- the spaces maintained and designated for use by all, allowing pockets of nature to sneak into the industrial landscapes. While Vashon is fortunately rural and has ample open spaces, it does not take great imagination to see that without designating and caring for these spaces they will not endure for future generations to use — nor be of use for the general public. As a Vashon native who is passionate about our community and the natural environment I would like to help make our conservation and enjoyment of these spaces secure for the future, accessible to all who wish to use them, and places for people to enjoy.

Vashon is also fortunate to have our own Park District – While I am also grateful for the county, state, and national parks I feel that a local Park District has the opportunity to create spaces and programs that are tailored for our community and reflect the values of the people who live here. Maintaining local governance over our lands and programs seems to improve the sense of ownership that Islanders feel toward their parks – and I think this is priceless.

I ask that you please consider me to fill the recently vacated position on your board. I would like to learn more about the state of the parks on our island and how to address the challenges we face. My hope is that my enthusiasm, creativity, and connection to our community will be an asset to the Board.
