You are cordially invited to attend a public meeting with the Vashon Park District Board of Commissioners and representatives from KPFF Consulting Engineers to discuss the 30% Engineer's Design for the replacement of the Tramp Harbor Dock.

You may recall with the last update in January that the VPD Board considered the public input we solicited in the fall and decided to move forward with refining a design for an approximately \$2.7 million replacement dock with a minimum 6' wide trestle and a minimum 12' x 30' end platform, to enhance the marine habitat and user opportunities.

### **Good News! It is better than expected!**

#### **Key Elements**

- 346 feet in length (but 16 feet inland from the current length due to the Point Heyer Geoduck Tract)
- 30' x 16' end platform
- 9' wide trestle
- Open coated steel grating to allow light penetration per DNR requirements
- Precast concrete piles
- Enhanced parking
- Beach access stairway
