CONTRIBUTING TO YOUR PARISH

There are several ways you can contribute to the building of God's community here at St. John the Beloved Church. From using your monthly envelopes at the Sunday Collection, to setting up recurring contributions using online giving, or even establishing a legacy gift.



We urge you to consider **Online Giving**. These contributions are automatically tracked in our system, and offer all the benefits of envelopes, without them being necessary. You can register for Online Giving through our website or our parish app. If you decide to use Online Giving, you may discontinue your envelopes by contacting the office.

Offertory Envelopes help the Parish Office connect cash and check contributions to the proper donor. Every year, we send out offertory statements for tax purposes. In order to ensure the correct information, envelopes are crucial for accuracy.

There will be times when verification of your church attendance is essential. For example, you need a record of your church attendance for

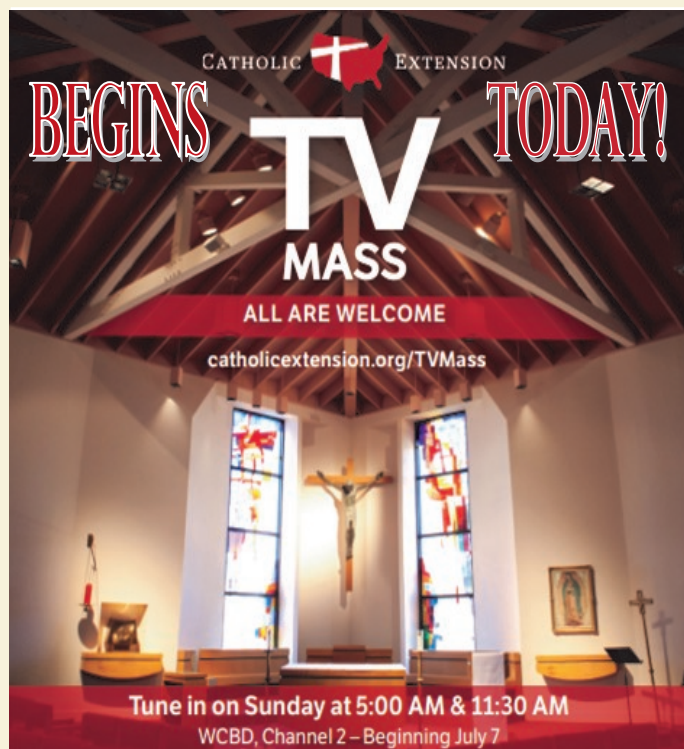
- Receiving parishioner tuition rates at a Catholic School
- Permission letters to marry at another church
- Sponsorship for Baptism and Confirmation

The only way for us to track your attendance is through your contributions. Online giving and offertory envelopes are the easiest way for us to track your church attendance. With loose checks, we make copies then look for your family number in order to post. With cash, we have no way of knowing who donated it unless it is placed in an envelope with your first and last name, address, and phone number. We track attendance so that we can gauge the health of the parish, reviewing figures to see if attendance is rising or falling. The Diocese also tracks parish attendance in order to set our parish goal each year for the Bishop's Annual Appeal. Thus, the envelope program helps both individual parishioners and the parish as a whole.

If you are not registered with the parish, please pick up a New Parishioner Envelope in the Church Commons or stop by the Parish Office during the week or register online on our website www.sjbsummerville.org Once registered, you will receive envelopes automatically. If we notice you are not using them, we delete your information from the list of recipients.

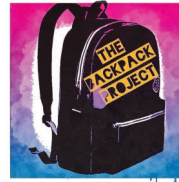

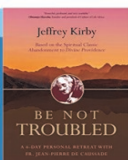

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

In today's Gospel passage from Luke, we find our Lord appointing disciples to go out and prepare others to receive His invitation into the Kingdom of God. Every verse has something to say about the way a Christian steward should approach others. Let's look at least one of the coaching tips Christ gives.



"The Lord appointed seventy-two others whom He sent out ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit." In His wisdom, Christ sent His disciples out not as individuals but in pairs, as teams. This approach to evangelization certainly provided practical advantages. The disciples could lean on each other for mutual support and encouragement, helping each other to stay on task and to put their heads together to pray and problem-solve. This teamwork approach is just as relevant to us modern-day Christian stewards. It takes courage and commitment to go out and invite others into the Christian life. We need to work together to do it well.

But there is also symbolic importance to working in teams. It points to the reality that when we invite others to embrace the Good News of the Gospel, we are not merely inviting them into a belief system, but into a relationship with Christ and through that relationship, into Christ's family — our fellow Christian disciples near and far.

Our parish is our immediate spiritual family in this extended worldwide fold. We are not meant to live as isolated individuals within the parish any more than we are meant to live in isolation within our families. We are meant to be a community. That is why it is so important for us to foster a vibrant, supportive, welcoming parish life. This is why we emphasize hospitality as one of the pillars of stewardship. It is not enough just to point others to Christ, we must invite them to join us in community with Him; we must offer a place and mission for them in the Church and within our parish family.
