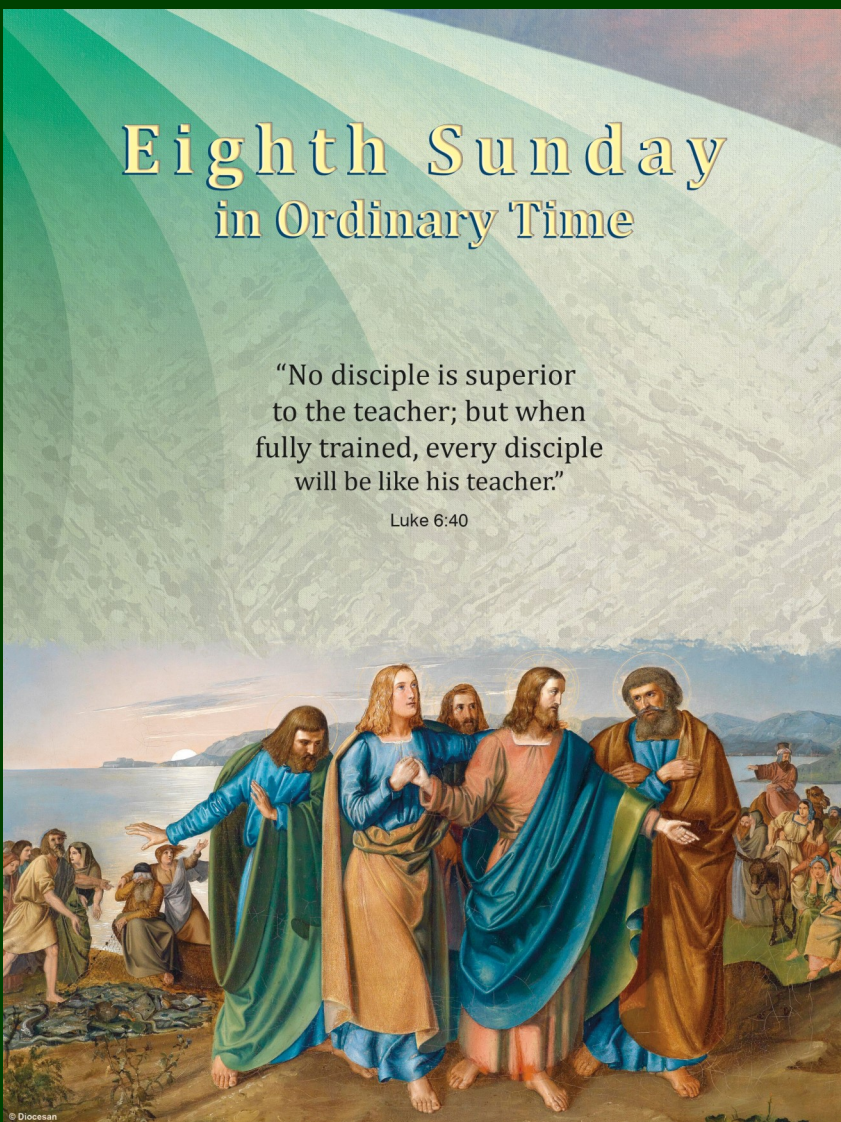

## LENTEN REGULATIONS

Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Catholics age 18-59 years of age are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday—a fast consisting of one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating in between.

It is also recommended that Catholics find opportunities through the Lenten season to complement their fasts with prayer, reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist, and positive works of charity.

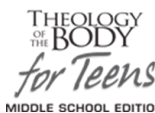
The senior luncheon for March will be on March 9, 2022 at 12:00 p.m. in
