

ACTIVE MEMBERS of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure.


Stewardship is determined by:

St. Patrick's Day dispensation

As the feast day of St. Patrick falls during Lent on Friday, March 17, Bishop Jacques Fabre-Jeune, CS, has dispensed all the faithful in the diocese from abstaining from meat.

"May the strength of God pilot us, may the wisdom of God instruct us. May the hand of God protect us, may the word of God direct us. May thy Salvation, O Lord, be always ours this day and for evermore.

Amen."

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
Catholics age 18-59 years of age are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Fridaya fast consisting of one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating in between.

It is also recommended that Catholics find opportunities through the Lenten season to complement their fasts with prayer, reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist, and positive works of charity.
