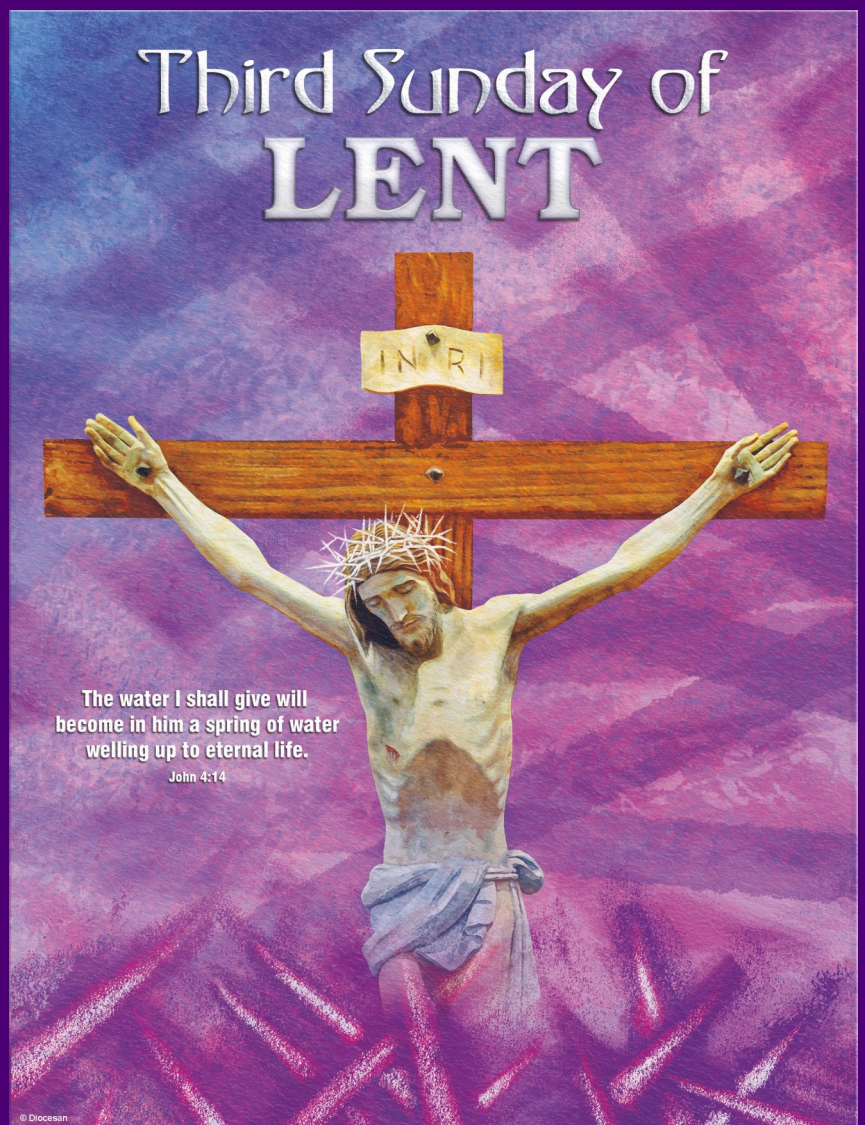

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. Catholics age 18-59 years of age are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday- a fast consisting of one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating in between.

It is also recommended that Catholics find opportunities through the Lenten season to complement their fasts with prayer, reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist, and positive works of charity.

THE SCRUTINIES AND THE RCIA TRADITION



The Scrutinies occur during the period of Purification and Enlightenment. They are celebrated at Mass during the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of Lent. These rites have a purpose of intense spiritual preparation and interior reflection. They are celebrated to

deliver the elect (those who are to be baptized) from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. The Scrutinies inspire the elect to desire knowledge of our Lord, purification, and redemption by Christ. (RCIA 139, 141)

Sunday, March 12th is THE FIRST SCRUTINY

In the first scrutiny we hear the gospel story of the Samaritan woman at the well. This story is to remind us that Jesus is the "Living Water" the becomes our spring of eternal life. This scrutiny calls the elect to follow the way of salvation and Truth in the Holy Spirit. During this Mass, the elect and those called to continue their conversion will be presented a copy of The Creed. This is to recall the wonderful deeds of God for the salvation of the human race.
