

ACTIVE MEMBERS of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure.


Stewardship is determined by:

THE SCRUTINIES AND THE RCIA TRADITION



The Scrutinies occur during the period of Purification and Enlightenment.
They are celebrated at Mass during the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of

Lent. These rites have a purpose of intense spiritual preparation and interior reflection. They are celebrated to deliver the elect (those who are to be baptized) from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. The Scrutinies inspire the elect to desire knowledge of our Lord, purification, and redemption by Christ. (RCIA 139, 141)

In the third scrutiny we hear the gospel story of the Raising of Lazarus. This story is to remind us that Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life, the God of the living and abundant life. This scrutiny calls the elect to bear witness to their new life in the risen Christ whose Spirit fills them with faith, hope and charity. During this Mass, the elect and those called to continue their conversion will be presented a copy of The Lord's Prayer. This is to fill them with a deeper realization of the new spirit of adoption by which they will call God their Father.
