Baby Bottle Campaign

KofC Madden Council #6629 and the Respect Life Committee will hold a drive for the KofC Aid and Support After Pregnancy Program (ASAP). All donations will go to the Pro-Life Charleston (PLC) Pregnancy Resource Center, which operates a mobile pregnancy unit through South Carolina to serve women in crisis pregnancies. All services are FREE and include pregnancy testing, ultrasound, limited lab work counselling and social service arrangements during pregnancy. Family support continues for two years after the baby's birth. The van goes to locations across the Lowcountry where the services are most needed (i.e., High School and college campuses, areas near abortion clinics; innercity neighborhoods, etc). The van also goes to schools to provide age-appropriate information about fetal growth and development. PLC needs both financial and material support. This newly "wrapped" Mobile Pregnancy Center Van will be in the church parking lot and people are welcome to tour it. Volunteers will be standing by the exits and in the commons to distribute/ collect baby bottles and or items. Please take a baby bottle home and return it with a donation of cash, loose change, or a check. If you write a check, please make it out to Kof C Council #6629. If you want to donate items, they could use diapers, wipes, baby, and maternity clothes. If you donate an item, please leave the price tag on. For every \$500 (items or money) K of C Supreme Council will provide a \$100 grant to that pregnancy support center. The drive begins on Mother's Day (May 14th) and ends on Father's Day (June 19th).

SUNDAY CONNECTION

The readings for the last few Sundays have been about the Resurrection, but today's Gospel takes us back in time to an event in Jesus' life before his Passion. Jesus tells his disciples that he is going to prepare a place for them in his Father's house. He promises that where he is going, his disciples will be able to follow. Thomas, who will later doubt the disciples' reports that they have seen the Risen Lord, contradicts Jesus by saying that the disciples don't know where Jesus is going or how to get there. Jesus explains that he himself is the way, the truth, and the life. In knowing and loving Jesus, the disciples now love God the Father.

Philip then makes a request that challenges Jesus' words. Philip wants Jesus to show the Father to the disciples. Recall that Jesus has just told his disciples, "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." As a good teacher, Jesus responds to Philip by repeating and elaborating on what he has just told the disciples: they have seen and known Jesus, so they have seen and known the Father. Then Jesus offers another reassurance about his departure: because of faith in God and in Jesus, the disciples will do the work that Jesus has done and more.

The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, "I am," so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: "I am the way and the truth and the life." The revelation of the Trinity is completed in the passage that follows today's reading, and it is the Gospel for next Sunday. Because Jesus goes away, the Father will send in Jesus' name the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will continue the work of the Father and of Jesus.
