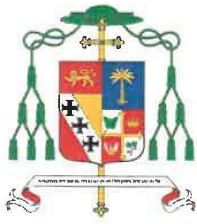

My dear sisters in Christ,

Today, we celebrate Mother's Day, a day that is designated to honor and cherish the women that gave us the gift of life. As it is also the month of Mary, I want to reflect with you on the power of a mother's intercession for her children.

I thank God for my mother every day. Because of her devotion and the prayers she prayed for me when I was a baby, I survived a diagnosis that doctors said I would never recover from. My mother brought me before the Blessed Sacrament and consecrated me to the Immaculate Conception. I can truly say that I am a living miracle because of the protection and intercession of Our Lady and my earthly mother. I am sure you have your own testimony of that relationship with your mother. 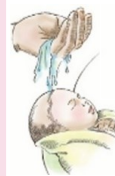
