



Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) Training Available

In the event of a cardiac arrest (heart attack), do you know how to use an AED? Providing an early shock to a cardiac arrest patient saves lives, especially when done in conjunction with CPR. The patients who receive assistance BEFORE the ambulance arrives are the ones who survive. Catholic Mutual Group now has online training available to give you the confidence you need to use this device effectively, even if you've never been trained before, even if you don't know CPR, even if you have been previously trained and think you might be a little rusty. If you have done Safe Haven training, you already have an account and are able to access the training. If you don't have an account, you can easily sign up for free.
