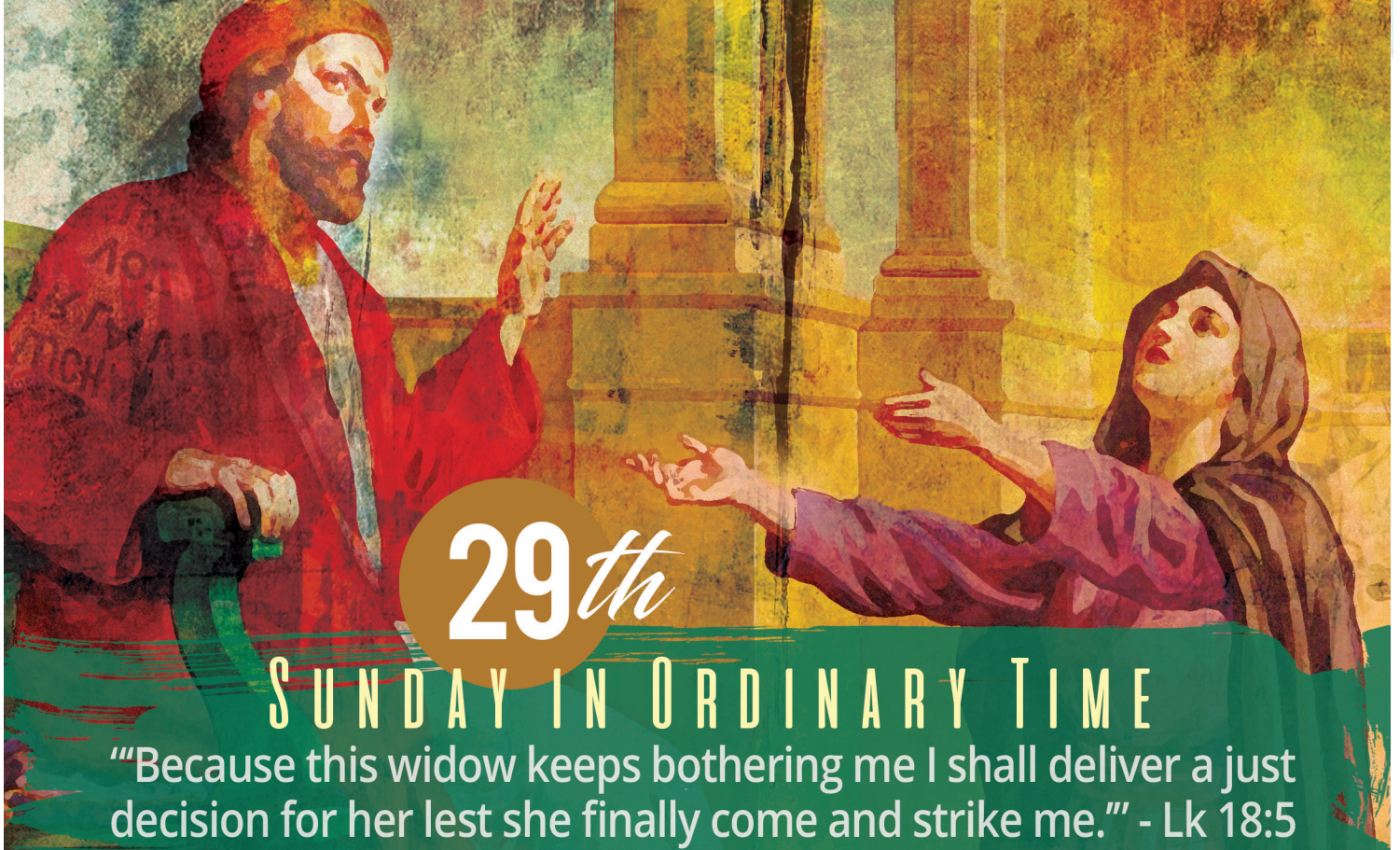

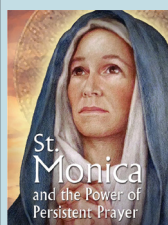

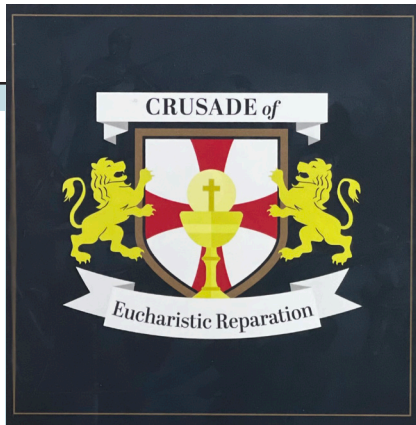
## Cenacle of St. Monica

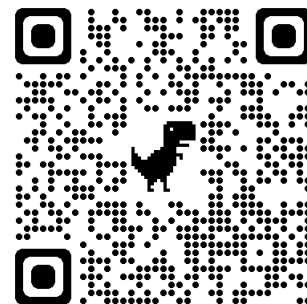

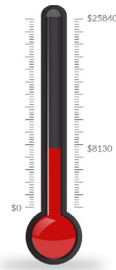
"The Return Of The Prodigal Son." He is a well known

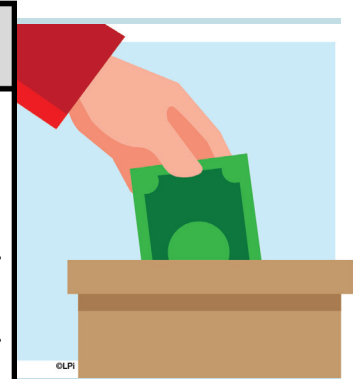
