

In a quiet mountain village, where winters were long and harsh, there lived an old man named Eli. MSGR. ANDRÉ J.M. TREMBLAY

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Msgr. André J.M. Tremblay on Thursday, May 8, 2025, at the age of 92. Son of the late Léon and of the late Rose-Alma (née Beaulieu) Tremblay, he was the 5th of 16 children. Msgr. Tremblay began his studies in 1948 until 1965 where he obtained various degrees in philosophy, arts and theology. In May of 1964 he was ordained a Deacon at St. Peter's Seminary in London, ON and then began his journey at St-Jacques Parish, Hanmer. A year later, he entered the priesthood after ordination on June 5, 1965, where he dedicated himself to a lifelong priestly ministry in many parishes in Northern Ontario; Sturgeon Falls, Wawa, Spanish, Serpent River, Dubreuilville, Elliot Lake, Dowling, Sudbury, Warren, Massey, Webbwood, Dokis, Markstay, Val Therese and Blind River. He will be remembered by his parishioners of St-Mathieu, Sudbury, where he led the church for the last 18 years of his career until his retirement on September 28, 2016. He will be remembered for his many years of ministry to the sick. Please remember Msgr. Tremblay in your prayers.
