Parish Information

♦ ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

Holy Hour is held every **Thursday** at **7:00pm** alternating between **Sacred Heart** & **St. Eulalia** locations except for the first week of the month. **Adoration** is held at **Sacred Heart** on the month's **first Friday**.

Confessions will be available. Location is announced weekly in the bulletin.

♦ BAPTISMS

Baptism arrangements must be made by **the PARENTS** at the rectory office.

All parents and godparents must be practicing **Catholic Christians**.

Baptisms are available at **Saturday 4:30pm Mass** in English and **Sunday 10:30am Mass** in Spanish at **Sacred Heart** or at **Sunday 10:30am Mass** in English and **12:30pm Mass** in Spanish at **St. Eulalia**.

English Baptism Ceremonies are at **2:00pm on Sundays** and Spanish Baptism Ceremonies are at **1:00pm on Saturdays**; on the **2nd** & **4th** weekend of each month at **Sacred Heart**.

The **mandatory** Baptismal preparation meeting for parents and godparents is on the **4th Monday of the month** at **7:00pm** in the **school building** at **Sacred Heart**. **Being registered parishioners will make arrangements easier.**

For full information on Baptism arrangements, requirements and restrictions please visit the rectory office for a consultation.

♦ CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

Join us on to pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** every **second Saturday** of the month at **3:00pm** in **St. Eulalia**.

♦ WEDDINGS

Arrangements should be made at the rectory with a parish priest or deacon

at least four months before the wedding. Normally weddings are for registered parishioners, but extraordinary circumstances may be considered.

We recommend a **Wedding Mass** for **practicing Catholics**.

We recommend a **Wedding Ceremony** for **non-practicing Catholics** or **mixed-religion couples**. Both are valid Marriages.

Weddings will NOT be scheduled during Lent.

♦ QUINCEAÑERAS

Arrangements must be made at the rectory office with a priest or deacon

at least two months beforehand. Quinceañera preparation meetings will be **required**. **Quinceañeras will NOT be scheduled during Lent.**

♦ FUNERALS

Arrangements can usually be made with the rectory office by the funeral director and the family. We have the Book of Funeral Readings and Music at the rectory or by email for families who wish to choose the readings and music. A priest or deacon will usually attend the wake.

♦ SICK CALLS

If someone needs to be anointed, please call the rectory when they are **seriously ill**. **Don't wait too long.** If someone homebound wishes to receive Holy Communion, please call the rectory.

African American Art is not just African or American it is also Caribbean, or it can lead you to Paris. Black American Art is a delicate blend with multiple flavors. Today we will try to get a taste of what this means in the field of visual arts. The African American painter Henry Ossawa Tanner, was born in 1859, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Tanner's mother Sarah was born enslaved but escaped to the North. Sarah's son Henry Ossawa Tanner was the first African American painter to gain international acclaim. His painting entitled Daniel in the Lion's Den was accepted into the 1896 Salon, the official art exhibition of the Academie des Beau-Arts in Paris. Many artists of his time were impressed by his paintings—many had biblical themes. Take the time to view his many works like Miraculous Haul of Fishes, Flight into Egypt, or The Banjo Lesson.

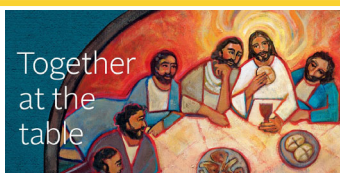

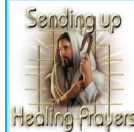
