OPERATION RICE BOWL KICK-OFF

As Lent begins, we invite everyone to participate in Operation Rice-Bowl by taking home a Rice Bowl. This project, run by Catholic Relief Services, provides a great opportunity for a meaningful Lenten observance. By following the daily suggestions in the rice Bowl calendar we observe the traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting & almsgiving. The Operation Rice Bowl program also gives us the chance to go further, by learning & helping as well. Through the Rice Bowl materials, we learn about the poor & underprivileged all around the world & we have the chance to help make their lives better by praying for them & giving what we save in the Rice Bowl to them. It's a great way to observe Lent & make the world a little better by helping the poorest of God's children. Please take a Rice Bowl home & participate in this worthwhile project. The Rice Bowls will be available in both English and Spanish in boxes at the church entrances.

LENTEN OBLIGATIONS



FAST & ABSTINENCE: Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age and older, and younger than 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

PRAYER: Please try to devote as much time to prayer & reflection as possible. Morning Mass is at **8:00am** every weekday at Sacred Heart! Stations of the Cross are prayed every Friday of Lent at **7:00pm** in **English** at **Sacred Heart** & **7:00pm** in **Spanish** at **St. Eulalia**.

ALMSGIVING: Please try to help the poor during Lent. There are a number of ways: Operation Rice Bowl, Alms for the Poor, donating Clothes to St. Vincent DePaul and Catholic Charities via the white clothes donation bin in the parking lot, & donating time and food to the St. Eulalia Quinn Center Food Distribution on Tuesdays.

OBLIGACIONES DE CUARESMA

AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA: Todos los católicos mayores de 14 años deben observar la abstinencia de carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Todos los católicos mayores de 18 años y menores de 59 años deben observar el ayuno el Miércoles de Ceniza. Aquellos que están obligados por esto pueden tomar solo una comida completa. Se permiten dos comidas más pequeñas si es necesario para las necesidades de uno, pero no se permite comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas. El ayuno pascual especial, así como la abstinencia, se prescriben para el Viernes Santo y se recomiendan para el Sábado Santo.

ORACIÓN: Por favor, trate de dedicar tanto tiempo como sea posible a la oración y la reflexión. ¡La misa de la mañana es a las 8:00 am todos los días de la semana en el Sagrado Corazón! Las Estaciones de la Cruz se rezan todos los viernes de Cuaresma a las 6:00 p. m. en inglés en el Sagrado Corazón ya las 6:00 p. m. en español en Santa Eulalia.

LIMOSNA: Por favor trate de ayudar a los pobres durante la Cuaresma. Hay varias formas: Operation Rice Bowl, Alms for the Poor, donar ropa a St. Vincent DePaul y Catholic Charities a través del contenedor de donación de ropa blanca en el estacionamiento, y donar tiempo y comida al St. Eulalia Quinn Center Food Distribución los martes.
