When Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary, He asked that His Heart—wounded on the cross—be venerated and adored as an embodiment of His Divine Mercy and love. Jesus asked that

all Catholics receive Holy Communion, especially on the First Friday of every month. He also asked that we seek forgiveness for our sins against His Sacred Heart and that the Church observe a feast day for it, which is always celebrated on the 2nd Friday after Pentecost...

...but the Church decided to dedicate the entire month of June to the Sacred Heart as well! Jesus made twelve promises to those who have a devotion to the Sacred Heart:

- **1.)** I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2.) I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3.) I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- **4.)** I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- **5.)** I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- **6.)** Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7.) Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- **8.)** Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- **9.)** I will bless every place in which an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.
- **10.)** I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- **11.)** Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.
- 12.) I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

ear friends of the Parish:

The devotion of Sacred Heart is love for Jesus Christ, and the love of Jesus Christ ought to be the principal devotion of a Catholic. It is sad when we pay attention to various devotions, but neglect devotion to the Sacred Heart. We have received the call to holiness and if we are not sufficiently encouraged to acquire the love of Jesus that is the reason why we frequently relapse into sin.

For this purpose it is related in the life of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, a nun of the Visitation Order, that our Savior revealed to this servant His wish that the devotion and the Feast of His Sacred Heart should be established and propagated in the Church. In this way, devout believers would, by their adoration and prayer, make reparation for the injuries His Heart constantly receives from ungrateful humanity when He is exposed in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar. It is also related that while this devout nun was praying before the Blessed Sacrament, Jesus Christ showed her His Heart surrounded by thorns, with a cross on the top, and in a throne of flames.

"Behold the Heart," she reports that Jesus spoke to her, "that has loved humanity, and has spared nothing for them, even to consuming itself to give them pledges of Its love, but which receives from the majority of people, no other return but ingratitude, and insults toward the Sacrament of Love."

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, is nothing more than an exercise of love toward our loving Savior. Therefore, the principal object of this devotion, the spiritual object of this devotion, is the love with which the Heart of Jesus is inflamed toward all. Let us now attempt to satisfy the devotion of those who are enamored of Jesus Christ, and who desire to honor him in the Most Holy Sacrament, by a novena of holy meditations and affections to His Sacred Heart.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

Next weekend, as we celebrate Fathers' Day, we pause to reflect on the gift fathers are to our families. We thank God for how they enrich our lives by their example, their support, their love and their wisdom.

It is also an occasion to honor those who father our parish communities, our priests who minister to us and tend to our needs as pastors. They come to mind as we recall the priest who performed our family marriages, who was at the bedside of a parent, spouse or child close to death, who baptized our children, who heard our confession and whose homilies gave us hope to carry on.

Today, we are given an opportunity to stand by them, as they have stood by us, by giving generously to this weekend's second collection in support of their health and retirement needs. The Priests' Health and Retirement collection is for the benefit of our 411 active and 253 retired priests. We all know how health care costs continue to rise. This year the expenses for health care, nursing and priests' retirement will total \$13 million. This is the only collection for our archdiocesan priests' health and retirement, those ordained to serve in our archdiocesan parishes. It is distinct from the annual collection for religious order priests, sisters and brothers, which was taken up earlier this year.

While our priests begin retirement only at age 70, many choose to stay active. And, many of those who do retire at seventy continue to let us know we can count on them by helping out on weekends in our parishes. Please join me in letting the sons of this archdiocese, who have stepped forward to give their lives in service to us, know that they can count on us. Join me in making a generous contribution to this weekend's second collection. Also, I ask you to consider naming the Priests' Health and Retirement as one of the beneficiaries in your will, something I personally have done.

Each day they stand by us, so let's stand by them now. We can do a lot if we all do our part. As we give thanks to God for our fathers on Fathers' Day, let's say a prayer for our priests, those who father our parishes.


