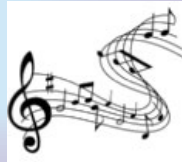

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

All of us have benefited in so many ways from the ministry of priests who have served us in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Before their ordination, these priests prepared over a course of years to serve us. Today, seminarians, when ordained, will be serving your children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. Some are in the pre-seminary spiritual year at Bishop Quarter House in the city. Others are completing their college studies at the University of St. Thomas in Saint Paul, Minnesota. Finally, those in the last four-year phase of preparation, are being formed at Mundelein Seminary.

Supporting vocations to the priesthood is a task that belongs to all of us in the Church. I want to invite you to express that support in four ways: pray for vocations and our seminarians in preparation, encourage those seminarians serving in your parish, urge young men to give their lives in service as priests, and make a financial contribution to support our programs of priestly formation. Prayer, encouragement, recruiting and financial support—all these actions express our gratitude to God for the gift of priestly ministry. These actions also build for the future of our Church and for our children and grandchildren. I would note that given that our seminarians need to invest themselves totally in formation, they are not able to work. Thus, we need to cover the costs not only for their education but other expenses such as health insurance and other personal support.

SPRED es un ministerio parroquial que brinda formación en la fe y alimento espiritual a personas con discapacidades intelectuales y del desarrollo de todas las edades y niveles funcionales.

El objetivo de SPRED es ayudar a niños, adolescentes y adultos con discapacidades a desarrollar una conciencia de Dios en sus vidas; de sí mismos como personas dignas, creadas y amadas por Dios; y de sí mismos como parte integral de la comunidad parroquial y de toda la Iglesia.

Esto se logra a través de asociaciones uno a uno dentro de una pequeña comunidad de fe. El ambiente pacífico y cuidadosamente diseñado, los lazos de amistad, las actitudes respetuosas y el compartir las celebraciones sacramentales ayudan a cada persona a descubrir los dones y las necesidades de cada persona en la comunidad.

Dios se descubre una y otra vez en medio de las experiencias de vida de cada persona y en el don de las amistades compartidas.

Una comunidad SPRED dará la bienvenida a personas con diferentes capacidades de uno de los siguientes grupos de edad:

- Niños:** 6 a 10 años de edad

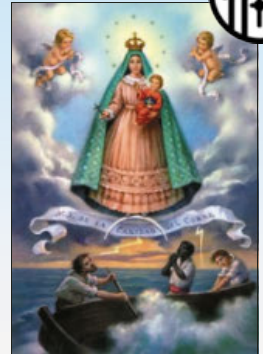

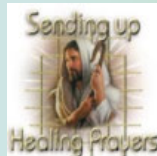

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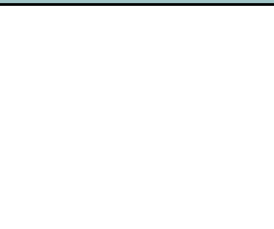
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
