HISTORY OF THE PARISH



NOTICE REGARDING SACRED HEART MARIAN HALL

THE HISTORY OF SACRED HEART & ST. EULALIA PARISH 2019 - PRESENT

THE NEW REALITY

As part of the Archdiocesan-wide Renew My Church effort, Sacred Heart Parish in Melrose Park merged with St. Eulalia Parish in Maywood on July 1, 2019. Two became one under the unified name "Sacred Heart & St. Eulalia Parish" under the leadership of Pastor Francisco Ortega with both "Sacred Heart Church" and "St. Eulalia Church" remaining open as two worship sites for the combined parish.

This new transitional period for two parishes with diverse communities was difficult for many, compounded by the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 which forced the parish to offer virtual Masses broadcast online via Facebook for the better part of two years. During this time, there was an initiative led by Father Francisco to reorganize and reinvigorate parish ministries and activities to encourage parishioners from both Sacred Heart and St. Eulalia to participate in their unified faith community.



ADJUSTMENT PERIOD

At the time of the unification, the Blessed Sacrament Fathers left the Chicago area and the new unified parish was left under the order of Archdiocesan priests. The Sacred Heart Rectory office was appointed as the main office of the parish by the Archdiocese of Chicago. Housing Forward expanded into the old St. Eulalia Rectory building while a small office was installed in the rear of church at St. Eulalia. All Sacramental records of both churches were consolidated into the main office at the Sacred Heart Rectory building. For the first time at St. Eulalia Church, weekly Spanish Mass began to be offered to serve Maywood's steadily growing Spanish-speaking community. Some renovations were done at St. Eulalia which included having the original tabernacle restored and placed on the high altar. A shrine dedicated to the Devotion of the Divine Mercy was constructed on the east side of the church with funds donated by parishioners.

Due to complications arising from the Covid-19 pandemic, amongst a variety of other factors, Sacred Heart School was permanently closed in June 2021.

The Quinn Center of St. Eulalia continued to provide community resources and activities for the unified parish under Executive Director Kristen Mighty. A special donation appeal held twice a year helped the parish provide support to the Quinn Center.

THE ANGELIC VISITOR

Some time during the Covid-19 pandemic, a lone white pigeon of unknown origin began appearing around Sacred Heart Church and claimed the window ledges of the eastern side of the Rectory as its home. The little bird survived hot summers, cold winters and captured the hearts of both parishioners and the Rectory office staff. The staff eventually named the pigeon "Angel" and Father Francisco took responsibility to make sure he had a reliable source of food and water.

After a few years, parishioners began to express concern that Angel could be in danger due to the presence of hawks and other such animal predators in the area. Having gained Angel's trust, Father Francisco took the pigeon in and found he was in excellent health despite surviving in the wild for so many years. Angel resided happily at the Rectory office until Father Francisco's term as pastor ended.



THE SECOND PARISH PASTOR

In the first few months of 2025, Father Francisco was notified by the Archdiocese of Chicago that he was being assigned to be the new pastor of Our Lady, the Mystical Rose Parish in Cicero. At the end of June 2025 Father took Angel, as well as the memories and experiences he had accumulated for many years, with him to his new parish. The Archdiocese of Chicago, after an extended period of deliberation, appointed Scalabrinian priest Father Marvin Ajic Arana, C.S. to be the new pastor of Sacred Heart & St. Eulalia Parish. Father Marvin began his new life as pastor on July 1, 2025.
