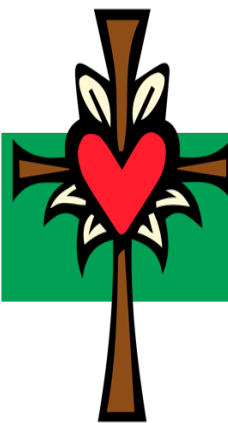

Dear Sacred Heart & St. Eulalia Parish community,

With joy and fraternal spirit, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for receiving me as your pastor into my new home, Sacred Heart & St. Eulalia Parish. I also would like to invite you to continue living with enthusiasm in our Missionary month, remembering that we are all missionaries since the day of our baptism. The mission is not only for some, but a universal call to announce God's love with our words, gestures and daily actions.

This is also a special opportunity to continue preparing ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope." Indeed, that is the motto of our Parish Jubilee as we celebrate the 2025 Jubilee year. We are called to be pilgrims in a Church that continues in search of the most suffered and hurt, especially in a year where we continue to experience many social and political challenges. This is a year of grace, and with a willing heart, we can obtain plenary indulgence offered by the Church as spiritual help in our path of conversion.

Plenary Indulgence is the total remission of the temporary punishment that is due for sins already forgiven, granted by the Catholic Church. This, in turn, does not forgive the sins themselves, but takes away all the temporary punishment that is due for the sins already confessed and forgiven. By temporary punishment we mean the consequences of sin that must be purified in this life or in purgatory.

How do you receive plenary indulgence?

Briefly and clearly, the necessary steps are:

- 1.) Sacramental confession (in the days close to the indulgence - **Thursday October, 23 at Sacred Heart 7:00pm**)
- 2.) Prayer for the Pope's intentions. (**Friday October 24 at St. Eulalia 7:00pm** - Stations of the Cross for Migrants).
- 3.) Perform the work established by the Church such as a pilgrimage, a work of mercy or a special prayer. (Parish Jubilee Pilgrimage to **St. John Vianney Parish** on **Saturday, October 25**)
- 4.) Eucharistic communion, with an attitude of grace and union with Christ. (Holy Mass **Saturday, October 25 at St. John Vianney 12:00pm**).
- 5.) Have an inner disposition of total distancing from all sin, even from venial sin.

Additionally, in other news:

The Lord has been good to us and we are happy! Thus, we take advantage of this communication to thank God for the arrival of the new **Associate Pastor** to our Parish, **Father Dinh**, who joins our community with a spirit of service and pastoral love. Welcome, Father, to this family of faith!

We encourage you to continue participating with joy and commitment in parish life, growing as brothers and sisters in faith, at the service of the Christ the Migrant and those most in need.

WELCOME FATHER DINH!

WELCOME TO OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR **FR. DINH** BIENVENIDO **PADRE DINH**, NUESTRO NUEVO PASTOR ASOCIADO

I am Dinh Duc Bui, and I am Vietnamese. I was born on August 8, 1992, to Mr. Thung Duc Bui and Mrs. Dao Thi Bui. I was born into a religious family in Vietnam, a country with a population of more than 98 million; 7% of the population is Catholic. I am the sixth of seven siblings. Two of my brothers are religious (both priests), both of whom are in Vietnam in the Cistercian Order.

My vocation began when I was a child; I felt God's calling from a young age. In 2012, I entered the Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Charles – Scalabrinians in Vietnam. I studied there for three years, then I was sent to the Philippines to study English and continue my Postulancy and Novitiate formation. On May 16, 2019, I made my First Religious Profession and was sent to Colombia to study Theology. On November 4, 2024, I made my Perpetual Profession. On February 1, I received the diaconal ministry and served as a deacon at Holy Cross Catholic Church in Kansas, USA. On September 22, 2025, I was ordained a priest by Bishop Alfonso Nguyen Huu Long, Bishop of the Diocese of Vinh.

Soy Dinh Duc Bui, vietnamita. Nací el 08 de agosto de 1992. Hijo del señor Thung Duc Bui y señora Dao Thi Bui. Nací en una familia religiosa en Vietnam, un país con más de 98 millones de habitantes; 7 % de la población es católica. Soy el sexto de siete hermanos. Dos de mis hermanos son religiosos (los dos son sacerdotes), ambos están en Vietnam en la Orden de los Cistercienses.

Mi vocación empiezo desde que yo era niño, sentí que Dios me llamaba. En 2012, Yo entre a la Congregación de Los Misioneros de San Carlos – Scalabrinianos en Vietnam. Allí estudié por 3 años, después fui enviado a Filipinas para estudiar inglés y seguir la formación de Postulantado y Noviciado. El 16 de mayo de 2019, hice mi Primera Profesión Religiosa y fui enviado aquí a Colombia para estudiar la Teología. El 4 de noviembre de 2024, hice mi Profesión perpetua. El 1 de febrero, recibí el ministerio diaconal e hice el misterio diaconal en Holy Cross Catholic Church en Kansas, USA. El 22 de septiembre de 2025 fui ordenado sacerdote por Obispo Alfonso Nguyen Huu Long, Obispo de la diócesis de Vinh.

(en los días cercanos a la obra indulgencia - **Jueves octubre 23, Sagrado Corazón 7:00pm**)
- 2.) Oración por las intenciones del Papa. (**Viernes octubre 24, Sta. Eulalia 7:00pm** - Viacrucis del Migrante).
- 3.) Realizar la obra establecida por la Iglesia como puede ser una peregrinación, una obra de misericordia o una oración especial.
(Peregrinación Jubileo Parroquial a la **Parroquia St. John Vianney** el **sábado octubre 25**)
- 4.) Comunión eucarística, con actitud de gracia y unión con Cristo.
(Santa Misa **Sábado octubre 25** en **St. John Vianney 12:00pm**).
- 5.) Tener disposición interior de alejamiento total del pecado, incluso del venial.
