eligible to be Godparents. Parents and  
Godparents are also required to attend a  
Baptismal Preparation Class before the Baptism  
takes place. Baptismal Preparation Class at our  
parish takes place on the 4th Monday of the

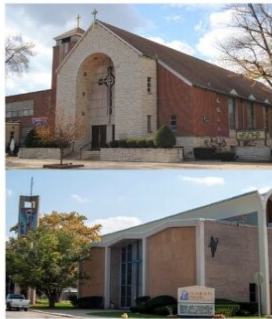
