

The three (3) dimensions of Love:

- eros: which signifies worldly love
 - philia: which signifies love of friendship
- agape (caritas): is an ablative love, becoming love or care of the other

Agape

Here is a summary of some Christian agape love characteristics

- God's love is placed in the human heart through the Holy Spirit
- It is God who first loves us, thereby enabling us to love Him in return
- Love does not harm one's neighbor but rather seeks to do to the other what one would want to be done to one's self

Love of neighbor cannot be separated from love of God, because it is an expression of our love of God.

With spring weather almost here, many are thinking of planting their vegetable gardens. Our clients are very appreciative of any fresh veggies we can provide. Please save your egg cartons for the months of April and May. We also are in need of macaroni and cheese as well as kids' cereal. Meat is in very short supply at the Food Bank and very expensive for us to purchase at the grocery stores. Your donations are very valuable to us and can be left in our cabinet located in the Baptistry.

Our food pantry participates in the South Michigan Food Bank Challenge during the months of April and May. 


