

### REFLECTION

The good Samaritan was also a good steward, giving his time and his treasure to meet his neighbor's need. At the end of this familiar story, Jesus urges His hearers — and us — to go and do the same!

## DEAR HOLY FAMILY,

“And who is my neighbor?” This question, posed to Jesus in this weekend’s Gospel is more important now than ever. In a time where it is easy to become divided by our differences, the Gospel calls us to recognize that God loves everyone regardless of our race, creed, color, and identity. In the *Treatise on the Love of God*, St. Francis de Sales explains that God’s love for us is like that of a gardener who plants diverse flowers in his garden. He writes: “The Church is a garden patterned with unlimited flowers. It is necessary that they should be of various sizes, various colors, and, to sum up, different perfections. All of them have their own value, their own charm, color and in the assemblage of their differences all of them produce a beauty that is most pleasing and perfect.” May we recognize that we are all different and our differences are not threats but gifts which help us here on earth and in Adrian to build up the Body of Christ, the Church.
