DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

With warmer weather finally here our minds automatically turn to summer. I know the kids are counting down the days until school ends and summer vacation begins.

As we prepare to say goodbye to another successful school year we also are planning to say goodbye to a building that has served the parish well for 100 years. Early in July the 4th street school will be razed. Generations of SPPS students have learned so much about themselves, the world around them and most importantly about God and faith in the 4th street school. Generations of CPPS Nuns and lay teachers have walked the halls and taught in the classrooms, helping young minds to grow and mature.

The 4th street school has a special place in the hearts of many, many people. The pastoral council, school board and others are planning ways for us to acknowledge the blessings received in the old school and give it a graceful farewell.

We will keep you updated about what is planned.

The next step in preparing for possible fundraising for a new parish hall is a feasibility study to be done by the company hired by the Diocese to conduct it's LIVING CHRIST Capital Campaign. We have been approved to combine our parish hall building with the Diocesan campaign pending the results of the study.

This feasibility study would be conducted in early summer.

Our initial design for the parish/center includes an attached gathering area on the west side of the church, a hall that would seat up to 150 which could be broken down into smaller meeting rooms when not in use, new restrooms, a choir practice room and a space for brides. The gathering area would also be designed with enough space for funeral visitations when requested.

This proposed addition would be in the space directly in front of the 4th street school.

While this is in the initial planning phase our parish leadership councils all find it very exciting. I know you share this excitement and we welcome any and all suggestions. Much more information and consultation will be coming as soon as possible.

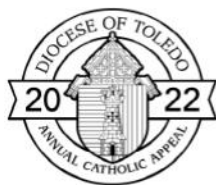
