God bless you and thank you for your interest in our high school mission trip to Laguna and Acoma, New Mexico. We are blessed to offer this opportunity serve the Pueblo communities. Our summer mission trip is open to current freshmen through seniors in high school. The Archdiocese Safe Environment training, CMG Connect, must be completed by anyone over the age of 18. If you are over the age of 18, graduated high school, and would like to attend, please reach out to the youth office. To be apply for the mission trip, please:

- 1. Fill out the parental consent/liability form.
- 2. Complete the application questionnaire via Google Forms:
- 3. Submit #1 and #2 with a \$50 nonrefundable deposit before March 31st. (check, cash to parish office, or online)



This packet will help answer any questions, but please reach out if you have specific questions. The anticipated cost per student this year is no more than \$550 (A bus costs \$13,000). Fundraising will help offset this cost and it is expected each young person will fully participate in our fundraising efforts. Final payment will be due July 1st. We have scheduled meetings below for students to get to know each other, learn about the trip, and best prepare for serving our friends in New Mexico. 7:00-9:00 P.M. Community Program or Student Ministry



Each student will be placed within a small group for daily chores and rotations of activities. Our hope is to have enough students to provide VBS in the morning and in the afternoon for Laguna and Acoma! Small groups will lead daily prayers, serve meals, clean bathrooms, visit homes together, etc. These small groups will have 2 adult leaders who have completed Safe Environment training for the Archdiocese of Galveston Houston.

New Mexico's summers are dry with average high temperature around 90° with lows in the upper to mid-40s. There is a chance the lows at night could reach the 30s. The weather is usually good! Sometimes it will rain and we have to walk through mud. The dry climate is a nice change of pace to Houston humidity.

Packing will be limited to one EYM duffle bag (you can borrow one or you can purchase one for \$35), your sleeping bag/pillow, inflatable mattress, and a carry-on backpack. We limit the number of bags you can bring to help with space limitations both on the bus and on the reservation.

We are immersed in the Pueblo way of life. Showers are not available daily. On shower days, we will shower in the travel center. These shower stalls are individually locked, private shower/bathrooms. This trip is full of sightseeing opportunities, the outdoors, service to others, Christian joy, and so much more!

Cell phone service is hit or miss. Phones must be kept out of sight during all gathered activities. We encourage your child to try and keep their phone off the entirety of the trip. They are welcome to use the group leader's phone when necessary.

No personal speakers, laptops, ipads, ipods/mp3 players, etc.

Energy drinks are not allowed on the trip.
