	Student must be enrolled in formal faith formation or Catholic School one year prior to Sacrament preparation year. Letter of Attendance required if student was <i>not</i> enrolled in faith formation at Epiphany last year. This includes Catholic schools other than Epiphany.
	Student must be enrolled in Epiphany faith formation classes or in Catholic school during their Sacrament preparation year.
