

Reconciliation and Eucharist Sacrament Preparation

Grades 2 through 11

Requirements:

- ☐ Student must be baptized in the Catholic Faith—if unbaptized or baptized in another Christian faith, contact 281-578-8271 for guidance.
- ☐ Student *must be at least 7 years old* **and** in the 2nd grade.
- ☐ Families must be registered parishioners of Epiphany.
- ☐ Families attend Mass weekly.
- ☐ Student must be enrolled in formal faith formation or Catholic School one year prior to Sacrament preparation year.
 - ☐ Letter of Attendance required if student was *not* enrolled in faith formation at Epiphany last year.
 - ☐ This includes Catholic schools other than Epiphany.
- ☐ Student must be enrolled in Epiphany faith formation classes or in Catholic school during their Sacrament preparation year.
 - ☐ Letter of Attendance required if enrolled in a Catholic school other than Epiphany Catholic School.
- ☐ Completed registration form for Sacrament Preparation required (one form / student).
- ☐ **Registration for Sacrament preparation is not complete without a copy of your student's Baptism Certificate.**

This certificate needs to be turned in even if your student was baptized at Epiphany. If you do not have a copy of the Baptism Certificate, please contact the church of Baptism for assistance in obtaining a copy.
- ☐ At least one Catholic parent must attend **Mandatory Parent Sacrament Meeting** to begin the preparation process.

Important Notice:

- ◇ Sacrament preparation **does not** take place in Faith Formation sessions or in Catholic school. Sacrament preparation is an additional and separate process with additional books and fees.
