



What are the dimensions of the artwork?

- Artwork should be no smaller than 8.5in by 11in and no larger than 11in x 17in.

What type of art medium may be used?

- All artworks should be hand-drawn which consists of artwork that uses pencil, paint, markers, crayons, etc.

What should be included in the artwork?

- Students are encouraged to use Scripture verses, slogans, catchy phrases, or other words to highlight the promotion of vocations.

How will the artwork be judged?

- Below is a rubric which teachers can use to give their students a grade. Judges of the contest will base winners on creativity, craftsmanship, effort, overall vocation message, and overall appearance of the artwork.

How do we submit entries?

- All submissions are to be submitted to our office by December 18, 2025. Please make sure that each entry has the school's name, the student's name and grade on the back of their drawing. Winning artwork will be given back to the student on the day of their recognition.

When is the artwork due?

- All entries must be submitted to the Office of Vocations by Thursday, December 18, 2025.

When will we find out the winners?

- Winners will be announced in February 2026.
