A happy **Labor Day Weekend** to one and all! There are many ways we can offer prayer related to work and labor. Let us be grateful to God for the ability to work to provide for families and to contribute to the social dimension of society. The **Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church** states, "Human work also has an intrinsic social dimension. A person's work, in fact, is naturally connected with that of other people. Today 'more than ever, work is work with others and work for others'" (Compendium, 273).

Moreover, let us pray for those who are injured and cannot work and those who can't find adequate work to provide for themselves and their families. It's also important to remember the necessity to rest from our labors in order to give worship to God and spend time with our families doing works of mercy. *Rest from work is a right*. As God "rested on the seventh day from all the work which he had done" (*Gen.* 2:2), so too men and women, created in His image, are to enjoy sufficient rest and free time that will allow them to tend to their family, cultural, social and religious life. The institution of the Lord's Day contributes to this. On Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation, believers must refrain from "engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, the performance of the works of mercy, and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body. Family needs and service of great importance to society constitute legitimate excuses from the obligation of Sunday rest, but these must not create habits that are prejudicial to religion, family life or health" (Compendium, 284).




