### THE MONTH OF MARCH IS DEVOTED TO ST.

**JOSEPH** - "In human life, Joseph was Jesus' teacher in their daily contact, full of refined affection, glad to deny himself to take better care of Jesus. Isn't that reason enough for us to consider this just man, this holy patriarch, in whom the faith of the Old Covenant comes to full fruition, as a master of interior life? Interior life is nothing but continual and direct conversation with Christ, so as to become one with him. And Joseph can tell us many things about Jesus. Therefore, never neglect devotion to him—*Ite ad Ioseph*: "Go to Joseph"—as Christian tradition puts it in the words of the Old Testament (*Gen 41:55*)" (St. Josemaria Escriva)

**GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION** - Franciscan priests and brothers are the custodians of the Christian sites in the Holy Land and they are counting on our financial help to assist them in providing presence, care and service on that holy ground. These dedicated servants of God work tirelessly to preserve the sanctuaries and shrines from the life of Jesus and the prophets. **EXTREME ABORTION** - Please join the efforts of Ohio Right to Life ([www.ohiolife.org/ballotinitiative](http://www.ohiolife.org/ballotinitiative)) to defeat the disastrous and extreme abortion amendment to the Ohio

Constitution. "*The proposed amendment would outlaw virtually any restrictions on abortion and all other procedures, including sex-change surgeries, that touch on reproduction, for both adults and minors. It would cancel out not only parental-consent laws but also mere parental notification for minors' abortions or sex-change surgeries; strike down health protections for people of all ages who undergo these procedures, including requirements that a qualified physician perform them; and erase any meaningful limits on late-term abortions.*"
