The first few weeks of school have gone very well. Our students are happy to be back at school and we are thankful to have them. We are participating in Mass weekly. Thank you to everyone who donated to last years JGS Annual Fund drive. We are seeing the fruits of your labor at JGS School. The new digital marquee in the front of the school looks great and is being constantly updated by Mrs. Grace in the school office. Our JGS Daycare now has a gated enclosure to ensure the safety of our smallest students and our teachers received bonuses from the annual fund that help maintain their salaries at 80% of public school teachers. We are also in the process of a few campus upgrades, including adding a Merry-Go-Round to our main playground, obtaining bids for new touchless bottle filling stations and awaiting our additional safety panic buttons for all of our remaining teachers. # Principal's Note

School is off to a fabulous start, thanks to our wonderful student body and dedicated faculty and staff. Our current enrollment at JGS is 336 students.

Daycare-23 4th- 30

Prek 3- 32

Prek 4-22

Kindergarten-32

1st- 39

2nd- 33

3rd- 33

The Daycare allowance is 12 children per class with 2 adults in each classroom. We limit grades Prek3-Prek 4 to 40 students total and 20 per homeroom. We limit grades K-6 to 50 students total and 25 per homeroom. Our student average this year is 17 students per homeroom. This is a wonderful ratio in any academic setting especially since the State of Louisiana allowance in grades K-12 is 35 students per homeroom. This puts JGS well below the student/teacher ratio allowed by the State Department of Education and ensures that the classroom experience is positive, personal, and very productive for each and every student. Please continue to share the good news about our wonderful school.

We appreciate your support as we work to provide a safe environment with excellent academics for all of our students. We will have our Lock Down drill on Wednesday, September 7th with Monroe City Police Chief Zordan; Director of Homeland Security, Archie Brown and State Police Investigator Hank Smith. Please discuss the importance of this drill at home with your children. We will sound the alarm and will use our school panic buttons during the drill.

We offer school tours by appointment each week. Also remember, our new family referral reward is \$300 per new family who enrolls and remains at JGS through December. We award these rebates in January each year. Please remember the State Law with the number of days allowed for unexcused absences according to Non-Public Bulletin 741. The State of La will allow 15 days total unexcused per school year. This is only 7.5 days per semester unexcused so please remember to send a doctor's excuse to school for illnesses requiring a visit to the doctor's office. These first few weeks of school have gotten off to a wonderful start thanks to the teamwork and cooperation of our JGS families, students, teachers and staff. May God continue to Bless Jesus the Good Shepherd School.

#### No Cell Phone Use In School Zone

(LA Revised Statue Title 32.300.8)

If you are driving through a school zone, during posted hours, it is against the law to use your cell phone or other mobile device for ANY REASON, including:

- · Making a phone call
- ·Texting
- · Social Networking

The only exceptions to this rule are:

- · You need to report an emergency (including traffic hazard or accidents.)
- · Your personal safety is at risk.
- · You need to report or avert a criminal act against someone (including yourself).
- · You are legally parked.
- · You operate an emergency vehicle and must use your cell phone as part of your job.

If you are caught using your cell phone in a school zone, a police officer could charge you with a moving violation.

## Free & Reduced Lunch

If you think you qualify for free and reduced lunch.
Please complete the free and reduced lunch application that was sent home the first week of school and return to the school office as soon as possible.

# JGS School Tardy Policy: PreK 3-6th Grade

Each student is allowed 2 unexcused tardies each nine week period. Upon the third unexcused tardy and each tardy thereafter, a fee of \$50 per child must be paid within 5 days of the offense. Excused tardies include medical and dental appointments or excuses at the discretion of the principal.

# **New Family Referral Incentive**

The new family referral incentive is \$300 per family. If you know someone interested in JGS School please ask them to call the school office for more information. When the new family enrolls, please ask them to list your name on the "referred" line on the new student application and you will receive a check by mail in January 2023 if your referred new family enrolls at JGS and remains thru Dec. 2022.

# **Mass Uniform Policy**

- · BOYS wear uniform shorts or pants with white oxford shirt. Boys in grades 4th-6th are required to wear the school neck tie (available at Midsouth Medical Scrubs, 3209 Breard St. Monroe)
- GIRLS in PreK 3–3rd grade wear jumpers and girls in 4th-6th grade wear skirts with sailor blouse and blue tie.
- · Please send your child to school in the proper uniform on Mass days. School Mass is at 8:10 a.m. each Friday and on Holy Days.
- · Please refer to the red student handbook or the school website for more information on the school uniform policy for Mass.

## Car Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

#### **MORNING DROP OFF**

- Daycare only should be dropped off at the double doors of Moore Hall. No older siblings are allowed to be dropped off here.
- PreK3 & PreK4 only should be dropped off at the church overhang. No older siblings are allowed to be dropped off here.
- Kindergarten, 5th & 6th grades with older siblings drop off at the gate by the gym.
- Grades 1st-4th with older siblings drop off at the Main Office.

#### **AFTERNOON PICK UP**

- Daycare only should be picked up at the double doors of Moore Hall. No older siblings are allowed
  to be picked up here.
- PreK3 & PreK4 only should be picked up at the church overhang. No older siblings are allowed to be picked up here.
- Kindergarten, 5th & 6th grades with older siblings picked up at the gate by the gym.
- Grades 1st-4th with older siblings picked up at the second awning on Good Shepherd Lane.
