If this is your first time using Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity's online registration system, you need to "Create Account." Visit the website shown below in **Step 1.**, then see **1b.** "If you are a **New User**" instructions below.

1. **REGISTER / SIGN IN to help work on our Northwestern Churches Coalition home build;**
click or visit: <https://tchabitat.volunteerhub.com/lp/NWchurches> and follow these steps:

- a. **If you are an Existing User**, click "Sign In" and then log in to your account.
- b. **If you are a New User:**
 - i. Click "Create Account" to create a new profile.
 - ii. Choose a user name and password.
 - iii. Complete the required information (red *), including emergency contact.
Indicate St. Joseph the Worker as your church affiliation.

Scroll down the sign-up page to see our specific August build dates.

2. **SIGN UP for a Construction Event**
 - a. You may work one day, or many days. There are a limited number of slots available each day. Number of remaining available slots per day are shown. Split shifts / half days are not allowed for safety reasons. Dates fill up quickly, so we encourage you to sign up the sooner the better.
 - b. Find the opportunity on the date you are available and choose "Sign Up." **Important:** After Sign-Up, read **EVENT DETAILS** for What to Wear, What to Bring, etc. Churches in our Northwestern Coalition take turns providing lunch and beverages during our two-week build. Please bring a re-fillable "sports" water bottle.
 - c. If you want to sign up for more than one day, click on **EVENTS** and go back into scheduler. It's helpful if you check "Keep Me logged In" when you first Sign In.

NOTE: To sign up another family member to volunteer, you first need to Sign Out of your account, then begin their Create Account /Sign In procedure (Step 1 a. or b.), then continue to Sign Up process (Step 2).

3. Confirmation & Reminder Emails

- a. You will receive an email confirming you have registered for the event. You will also receive a reminder email shortly before your volunteer day.

OTHER VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES...

BEVERAGE or LUNCH DELIVERY:

Pick up donated lunches at a designated restaurant/grocery store; or food, beverages/ice at SJTW, and deliver to the build site.

FOOD PREP OR BAKING:

Clean fruit, bake treats or snacks, etc.
